



Tiscali: Former CEO Tommaso Pompei renounces to the exercise of options under a stock option plan approved in 2007

Cagliari, October 1st 2009

Tiscali S.p.A, announces that Tommaso Pompei, has renounced to 359,314 options to purchase an equivalent number of shares of Tiscali SpA. These options were granted to Mr Pompei under the stock incentive plan approved by a resolution of the Shareholders' Meeting of Tiscali S.p.A. on 3 May 2007 and would have become exercisable during the period from May 4, 2010 and November 3, 2010 at a unit price of exercise of Euro 24.77.

The Company today holds 260,000 treasury stocks which are, therefore, no longer tied to the above mentioned incentive plan.
